


3 Location








3.1.2 Parking

Use the underground line U6 (the brown line) to get to the station Michelbeuern-






4 Facilities

4.1 Indoor area




The Indoor area is located right next to Meet the Teams area. It consists of a corridor and a preparation room which will be shared by all participating teams. Either the corridor or the changing room can be used for changing or preparation. These areas will not be open to the public, however – some occational employees/workers may pass through.





4.2 Toilets



Toilets (orange marking) can be found at the indoor space right next to the "meet the team" section. These toilets unfortunately only offer limited usability for wheelchairs, but <u>might</u> be usable for catheterisation. Alternatively the shared preparation room, might also be used for emergency catheterisation.

The next fully functional toilet **barrier free toilet (green marking)** is located in at the corridor providing access to the general hospital. This toilet requires a EuroKey which will be provided if necessary. In case of having troubles, please contact the information desk for obtaining personal guidance.







4.3 Preparation room

In addition to the indoor corridor, a small room is available to be shared by all participating teams. A simple massage bed will be provided.






4.4 Food / Drinks
